The 2020 Tentative Assessment Roll for the Town of Ghent was completed and filed on May 1, 2020. It may be viewed at [www.townofghent.org](http://www.townofghent.org) and [www.columbiacountny.com](http://www.columbiacountny.com).

With NYS currently on New York Pause, the Board of Assessment Review for the Town of Ghent will meet to hear and examine all properly filed complaints in relation to assessment of Real Property on May 26, 2020, 4-8 pm via videoconference, specifically *Zoom*. Property owners are not required to be present at Grievance, however, anyone wishing to participate in or view the proceedings should visit [www.townofghent.org](http://www.townofghent.org) on or after May 1<sup>st</sup> to find the Zoom invitation.

Property owners needing to grieve their 2020 tentative assessment are strongly encouraged to submit their grievance application and supporting documentation prior to May 22<sup>nd</sup> to: Ghent Assessor, PO Box 98, Ghent, NY, 12075, or by emailing [ghentassessor@fairpoint.net](mailto:ghentassessor@fairpoint.net)

If possible, property owners should file their supporting documentation electronically so that it can be more easily shared with the BAR.

Property owners who wish to be heard by the Board of Assessment Review on May 26th, should call the assessor's office (518-392-4644 ext. 204) prior to May 22<sup>nd</sup> to request a time at which they should join the video conference on May 26th. This will help to facilitate the process.

All grievance applications and supporting documentation must be filed no later than May 26<sup>th</sup>.
